Location

The Canadian Ice Academy (The C.I.A.) is located at 3111 Universal Drive in Mississauga; south of the 401; north of the QEW; just west of the 427; take Dundas Street west; north off Dundas Street to 3111 Universal Drive.

Policies & Information

The Canadian Ice Academy is a privately owned facility. All users and visitors must have purchased a current and active package and/or ticket and are expected to adhere to the code of conduct within the facility.

The Canadian Ice Academy reserves the right to change, cancel and/or reschedule any and all on ice, ballet and/or off ice sessions based on enrollment, qualifications, test days, seminars, special events, etc.

All skaters and coaches must be members in good standing within the association of Skate Canada or their respective associations.

All packages are sold as is, by the week and with no alterations or substitutions.

There is a minimum 2 week purchase for ALL packages including CanSkate & Advanced CanSkate.

Policies & Information

All packages include one spin/stroking/turn session, 2 free skating sessions, one off ice dance class per day and 2 fitness classes per week. The pre-preliminary and preliminary skaters have two other package options which include one free skating session and one off ice dance class per day for the week. Or, they have the option to purchase this for a 3 day a week package.

Please note: The Canadian Ice Academy has a no refund policy.

Registration priority will be given to Canadian Ice Academy Winter package purchasers on & before **Friday April 9, 2010**; all 7 week registrations; then first come first served following **April 9th**.

Priority for sessions 5 & 6 will go to 7 week registrations who skate 2 sessions per day, then to those who skate one session per day and finally to the 3 day per week registrants.

All applications will be dated when received with deposit or full payment and will strictly follow the priority sequence. All sessions are limited to 30 athletes.

All skaters must have passed the complete test prior to the beginning of summer school in order to qualify for their designated sessions. Skating up must be requested by the coach in writing and approved by the Director.

All package holders and ticket skaters must 'sign in' at the office prior to stepping on the ice.

Please note that there will be NO ticket skaters allowed on any of the sessions (1 through 6) unless approved directly by the Director. Guest Skaters will be allowed at the discretion of the Director. Ticket skaters may skate on the 8:15 am OPEN session only.

Sessions did fill quickly last summer so please register early to avoid disappointment and to receive your initial request.

Test Days

Test Weeks are #2 & #7: July 9th & August 9th (tentative) (price remains the same)

Competitive Tests will be centralized.

Skaters must be registered in the Canadian Ice Academy Summer Program at least 3 full weeks in order to try a test.

A letter of permission from the athlete's home club must be supplied to the office prior to trying any test.

Ticket purchasers are NOT eligible to try any tests.

The ice schedule on these test dates will be fully or partially cancelled depending on the number of tests being tried.

Please note that all weeks are the same price.

Off ice classes will run as scheduled during these test sessions.
